

COMPACT VELO SAFE

Packing Instructions

Our COMPACT VELO SAFE has the same features as our original VELO SAFE and VELO SAFE II. It has been designed to accommodate most road and mountain bikes. It is constructed of tough ABS plastic, reinforced metal supports, lockable steel latches, easy roll casters, and a fork mount to secure your bike in one position. It's smaller size allows for easy handling, and fits into most compact cars and trucks.

1. Remove the pedals and the front and rear wheels from the bike.
2. Secure front fork to the fork mount positioned at the front of the case. The bottom bracket of bike will sit on a foam pad in the center of the case.
3. Secure each chain stay with the Velcro straps that are positioned to the rear of the foam pad and pull down securely.
4. The handlebars and stem should be removed as one unit. Because the case has been down-sized, it may be necessary to loosen your aero bars to make them fit more easily. For most bikes, it is not necessary to disconnect cable runs or brake hoods. Use the extra Velcro straps provided to secure the handle bar against the frame.
5. Remove the skewers from each wheel. Place each wheel on either side of the bike frame. The axle on each wheel can rest on the metal frame of the case or be removed. Secure the wheels to the top of the bike with the extra Velcro strap provided.
6. Lower saddle or remove if necessary and store at bottom of case.
7. We recommend pipe insulation foam for extra padding that is available at any hardware store. You can also use the packing foam for extra padding that is used between the top and the bottom of the case when originally shipped to you. There is plenty of room for extra gear, i.e. helmet, shoes, wetsuit, etc.
8. Place the top of the case on the bottom. The front of the top has a metal footmen's loop to attach a pull strap. Secure all latches and outer straps. One locking latch is positioned on each side of the case.
9. The airport Gorillas and TSA personnel are so hard on bike cases, make sure you attach the Velcro straps over the latches.

TRI ALL 3 SPORTS guarantees all its products for one year from date of purchase for workmanship and materials. Damage incurred during use is not warranted but may be sent to TRI ALL 3 SPORTS for repair. Fees charged for repair are based on extent of damage.

*Always check your Bike Case before leaving the airport since you never know what the baggage room Gorillas have tried to do with your case. If you notice any damage and suspect it was the fault of the airlines, make sure you report it to an airline official before leaving the airport and give us a call.

CAUTION: UPS does not insure or warranty the primary package, i.e. your COMPACT VELO SAFE that you are shipping your bicycle in. If the primary package is damaged, UPS will not reimburse you for it. They will insure the contents of the primary package, but not the primary package itself. PLEASE BE AWARE OF THIS. With the cost of UPS going up, we recommend that you take it on the airplane with you. At least the airlines will cover any damages to your case by the airline gorillas.
